



CRESTAVILLA EARNS LEED CERTIFICATION FOR GREEN BUILDING STANDARDS

September 18, 2020 (Laguna Niguel, Ca) – Crestavilla, an Atria Signature Residence, is now LEED Gold® certified for its green building design and sustainable practices. It is the first senior living community in Orange County to receive this distinction from the U.S. Green Building Council®.

Crestavilla, which opened last summer, uses 70 percent clean, renewable energy, and 20 percent less water than the average commercial building. It was designed with eco-friendly features including drought-tolerant landscaping, energy efficient appliances, solar-powered roof panels, motion-activated LED lighting and an ozone-protective laundry system.

The Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design™ designation is the internationally accepted standard for verifying a building is designed, constructed and operated with sustainable practices.

Since the beginning of March, Atria has taken extensive steps to protect the health and safety of its residents in light of the COVID-19 pandemic and is pursuing the safety-first distinction recently created by the USGBC.

“We care deeply about creating a healthier planet for future generations,” said Sarah Laloyan, Regional Vice President at Crestavilla. “Green practices are one of our priorities because it’s important to our residents. They want to know we’re committed to serving their great-great-great-grandchildren, too.”
